# ABOUT THE BRITISH INSTITUTE OF HOMEOPATHY

The British Institute of Homeopathy was founded by Dr. Trevor Cook in London, England, in 1987. Intent on furthering the practice of Homeopathy Internationally, the BIH teaches Homeopathy according to the principles developed by Dr. Samuel Hahnemann, founder of Homeopathy, without losing sight and understanding of the various modern approaches.

The Institute has developed a worldwide reputation, and there are over 11,000 students in over 77 countries who have successfully completed their studies, or are presently studying courses in Homeopathy, Aromatherapy, Herbology, Nutrition, Human Sciences, and other complementary therapies. Experienced Practitioners and Teachers provide personal quality tutoring by distance learning through mail/email as well as classroom study to students around the world.

## Dr. Trevor Cook

Dr. Cook was born in London, England. Holding degrees from the University of London and working in orthodox pharmaceutical research. He played a significant role in the development of several of the world's safest allopathic drugs. His discovery in 1965 of the synthesis of a major anti-hypertensive agent was patented worldwide (US. Merck #3,164, 588 1). Later he became visiting Professor in Pharmacology at the City of London University.

Managing Director of Nelson's Homeopathic Pharmacy, London (1977-1985), Dr. Cook held a *Royal Warrant* as manufacturer of homeopathic medicines for HM Queen Elizabeth and HM the Queen Mother, and he also held the *Royal Warrant* as personal supplier of animal health and nutrition products to HM Queen Elizabeth. He then became U.S. President of Dolisos (France), manufacturers of homeopathic medicines, and President of Mylans Homeopathic Pharmacy, San Francisco.

A renowned lecturer in Europe, the United States, India, Italy, Pakistan, Singapore and Canada, he has written many books, some translated into other languages. They include homeopathic topics such as: "*Samuel Hahnemann: Founder of Homeopathy*", "*The A to Z of Homeopathy*", "*Homeopathic Medicine Today*", and "*The Homeopathic Workshop*". He is well known on radio and television world-wide as a tireless promoter of Homeopathy. Dr. Cook is founder and former editor of Homeopathy International, a former member of the Advisory Council of American Homeopathy and a former member of the United States Homeopathic Pharmacopoeia Convention.

He is the former President of the **UK Homeopathic Medical Association**, a professional body for homeopathic practitioners, former Dean of the **Hahnemann College of Homeopathy in Santa Monica**, and now Principal/ Director of **The British Institute of Homeopathy**. For his services to Homeopathy and the disabled, he was awarded a gold medal at the International Homeopathic Congress in 1993. He is the publisher of papers that have advanced the world's understanding of homeopathic potency theory and nutrition, and led to new bio-chemic remedies and new homeopathic treatment of malaria.

# GENERAL INFORMATION

## Accreditation

All courses are recognized and accredited by many organizations and professional bodies in many countries, including: The National Association of Homeopathic Groups, The British Faculty of Osteopathy, The Society for Complementary Medicine, The Association of General Practitioners of Natural Medicine, the UK National Pharmacy Association, and The Association for the Promotion of Animal Complementary Health Education. The British Institute is also affiliated with The Institute for Complementary Medicine. Graduates may apply for membership of The Homeopathic Medical Association on completion of the full Practitioner Study Program entitling to the use of the initials MHMA. Graduates of the Practitioner Program may also apply for membership with the UK Alliance of Registered Homoeopaths (MARH) as a Registered Practitioner (RHom).

Internationally, the courses of the Institute are widely recognized by many bodies, including: The Federation of Homoeopaths, The American University of Complementary Medicine, The Society for Ultra-molecular Medicine (USA), The Alternative Medicine Foundation (USA), The American Naturopathic Medical Association, The African Homeopathic Medical Foundation, The International Federation of Practitioners of Natural Therapeutics, Pakistan Homeopathic Physicians and Pharmacists Association, The Asia Homeopathic Association, The Jain Homeopathic Foundation (India), The Ontario Homeopathic Association (inquire for details on various levels of membership), The Canadian National United Professional Association of Trained Homeopaths (NUPATH), Homeopathic Medical Council of Canada (HMCC), The American Council for Applied Clinical Nutrition, The Australian Traditional Medicine Society, the American Association of Drugless Practitioners (AADP Certification), and the National Board of Homeopathic Examiners.

The British Institute of Homeopathy was granted the exclusive right to its style and title by the Secretary of State of The Department of Trade and Industry in 1996 (UK). The British Institute is registered as a Training Provider with The Department for Education and Skills for Career Development Loans, Registration No. 2721, which must be quoted on application (UK).

*Please note that successful completion of courses with The British Institute of Homeopathy - Canada does not constitute licensing to practice. Regulations can vary or change from province to province and need to be inquired into and adhered to according to local rulings.*

## Course Commencement

Courses may be commenced at any time throughout the year and students may study at their own pace to achieve whatever goal they set for themselves. The Human Sciences, Nutrition, Herbology, Veterinary Homeopathy, Aromatherapy, Woman's Health, Dental and Bach-Flower courses may be taken concurrently with the Diploma, Practitioner, or Postgraduate courses in Homeopathy.

## Tutors

For all Institute courses the student is assigned a personal tutor who will mark and comment on their test papers and exams to guide them through the course on a friendly and informal basis. All our tutors are experienced practitioners/teachers themselves and will assist you in achieving whatever goal you set yourself.



### **Textbooks**

The Institute recommends the study of homeopathic literature for further support of course work. Certain books are considered essential and required reading. All books may be purchased from homeopathic pharmacies, some health stores and book suppliers, or by mail from the Institute. A book list and contact information for recommended suppliers will be enclosed with your course material.

### **Examinations**

All examinations taken by the students must be proctored. Students may sit the examination in a Solicitor's office, with a Justice of Peace, Notary Public, a Church Minister or an individual approved by the Director, Liz Henderson. In some cases, a short oral examination may be given by telephone to postgraduate students.

### **Newsletters**

Awards, seminars and items of BIH interest are announced in regular newsletters supplied free to all current students and Fellows of the Institute.

### **The Samuel Hahnemann Prize**

Prizes are awarded each year to the best students of the Institute in the United Kingdom and Canada. The awards are presented by our Patron, Mr. William Tankard-Hahnemann, where schedule and location allow.

### **The British Institute Research Council Award**

The B.I.R.C. was formed in 1997 following the recognition of the British Institute by The Secretary of State for Trade and Industry as, inter alia, a research organization. Details of current research projects or published articles may be obtained from the Registrar (UK), or may be seen in Institute Newsletters.

### **Equivalencies and Accreditation of training hours**

Equivalencies will be considered for sections of courses offered by the Institute. Students may test out of certain pre-requisite courses or sections of courses if they have satisfied equivalent amounts of course studies. Copies of transcripts or documentation to this purpose will be requested by the Institute at the time of enrollment to satisfy any exemption from a course or a section of a course.

A fee in Canadian funds will apply to test out of a pre-requisite course or section thereof.

### **Transcripts**

On request, transcripts, copies of certificates or personal references are supplied through the main office. A fee in Canadian funds will apply.

### **Change of Address**

Students taking home study courses may continue their studies on change of address or their country of residence at no extra charge, without changing their personal tutor.

### **Clinical Training Facilities**

Clinical Training Facilities are available to all graduates for clinical observation/experience at many homeopathic clinics and offices in UK, Canada, and worldwide as part of the **Practitioner Study Program**.

# GENERAL DIPLOMA COURSE

This course consists of 30 written lessons, test papers and three exams to enable the student to monitor his or her own progress. Written lessons are supplemented by audio and DVDs which may be retained by the student. Each student has an expert personal tutor who will mark papers and guide the student through the course on a friendly, informal basis. The first, second, and final examinations are to be proctored and signed by the student to declare the work as their own.

## Eligibility

This course is intended for students with a good general education and a commitment to Homeopathy or to physicians, osteopaths, chiropractors, dentists, nurses, and practitioners of other medical and wholistic health oriented therapies.

Applicants with secondary education and a commitment to homeopathy are also eligible. Students may enroll directly for the Diploma course. The course can be studied entirely by distance learning and it may be commenced at any time. In-class seminars at various locations are available (Toronto and Ottawa). You may contact the Canadian Office for details.

## Course Duration

The duration of study for this course is calculated at approximately 10-12 months and consists of additional weekend seminars. Students work at home in both options and can study at their own pace in the distance learning option but in-class is offered in some areas. Your personal tutor will assist you to achieve whatever goal you set to complete the course.

*History of Homeopathy; Sources of Remedies; Samuel Hahnemann; Arndt Schultz Law; Homeopathic Pharmacology; Preparation of Homeopathic Remedies; Potentization; Trituration; Avogadro's Hypothesis; Quality of Homeopathic Medicines; Classification of Medicines; Classical Homeopathy; The Organon of Medicine; Law of Similars; Gemmotherapy; Constitutional Concepts; Combination Remedies (Poly-pharmacy); Allergies; Modalities; Acute and Chronic Disease; Case Histories; Evaluation of Symptoms; Pharmaceutical forms; Homeopathic Pharmacopoeia; Attenuation; Principles of Homeopathy; Philosophy of Homeopathy; Biochemic Remedies (Tissue Salts); Laws of Direction of Cure (Hering); Homeopathic Materia Medica; Anatomy and Physiology (Introduction); Pathology and Homeopathy (Introduction); Potencies; Nosodes; Sarcodes and Isodes; The Chronic Diseases (Hahnemann); Miasms; Organotherapy; Bach Flower Remedies; Case Taking; Repertorization; Bowel Nosodes; Related Therapies; Research and Development; Computerized Homeopathy; Lithotherapy; Medication Techniques; Dispensing; Storage of Homeopathic Medicines; Homoeo-therapeutics; The Vital Force (Dynamis); Kotschau Studies.*

## Award

On successful completion students are awarded the **Diploma of The British Institute of Homeopathy, DIHom.**

## General

Graduates holding the Institute Diploma are eligible for direct entry to the **Practitioner Program** of the Institute and the award of Fellowship.

# HOMEOPATHY IN PRACTICE

## **Advanced Case Taking and Repertorization**

This course is an essential stage in our popular **Practitioner Study Program**. It is recommended for concurrent or subsequent study with the Institute's Diploma Courses. This superior course provides the essential studies to develop the skills and tools for case-taking, case-analysis, and case-management in daily homeopathic practice. It is intended for students wishing to establish a homeopathic practice.

**Duration** of study is calculated at 6-8 months.

## **Eligibility**

Students must hold or be studying for the General Diploma of the Institute of Homeopathy (DIHom) or the equivalent award of other approved schools of homeopathy. Graduates holding the Postgraduate Diploma, the Diploma in Veterinary Homeopathy or in Dental Homeopathy are also eligible.

## **Syllabus**

*Case analysis options; Aetiology; Miasms; Drainage; Bowel nosodes; Remedy-Groups; Remedy-Families; Taking the Case; Repertories and how to use them; Computerized Repertorization; Evaluating Repertorization; Case studies; Case management; Contemporary Case-analysis concepts; Guidelines for specific disorders; How to gain most from clinical observation; Guidelines for setting up in Practice; and more topics.*

## **Award**

Successful completion is awarded with a **Certificate in Advanced Case-Taking and Repertorization**. This course, or equivalent, is required for the study towards the **DIHom Practitioner Diploma**.

# CLINICAL INTERNSHIP

## **Live Case Studies**

Required are 20 cases, acute and chronic with several follow-up consultations to be studied under supervision by a personal tutor or with a BIHC approved Practitioner on-site. In certain locations this course is also taught in the form of in-class seminars with live case studies. ## **Eligibility**

Holders of the General Diploma Course, HIP, Veterinary, Dental or Postgraduate Diplomas of the Institute or equivalent studies through other approved colleges.

## **Syllabus**

Practical Application of: *Case-Taking approaches; Case-Analysis options; Repertorization Strategies; Case-Management; The Follow-up Consultation; Miasmatic Analysis; Understanding the Case; and other topics.*

## **Award**

A Certificate of completion will be awarded on successful completion of the course. Hours accredited may depend on study option chosen and are a requirement for the Practitioner Program.

**( Please note: This study-module can also be taken independently/repeatedly, in Canada, UK, or other countries, for additional credits, such as may be required for certain professional memberships, certifications, or future standards of homeopathic training and practice.**

# POSTGRADUATE COURSE HOMEOPATHY

## Eligibility

Applicants for this course must be holders of a Diploma of the Institute for the DIHom(Pract.), an equivalent qualification from a recognized college or have previous experience in homeopathic practice. Candidates are likely to be Homoeopaths, Veterinary Surgeons, Physicians, Pharmacists, Dentists, Physiotherapists, or other advanced health professionals.

## Course Program

The Postgraduate Course is unique and stimulating. It contains much new and unpublished information and presentations with an entirely new approach designed to develop the creativity of the student.

**Duration** of study for this course is calculated at approximately 10-12 months. Your personal tutor will assist you in achieving whatever goal you set for yourself. It offers a multi-faceted course program comprising of:

1. Thesis: A short, original thesis of not less than 15,000 words is presented by each student on completion of the course.
2. Practical Work: A practical exercise in homeopathic pharmacy to enable practitioners to prepare remedies.
3. Audio and visual CDs or tapes.
4. Personal Tutor: An expert Professional Homoeopath is assigned to assist every student on a personal basis.
5. Examinations: There is a mid-course examination and a final examination to be proctored.
6. Seminars: Postgraduate Course students may attend optional seminars held by the Institute at various centers worldwide from time to time.
7. Case Studies: Students are required to submit five case studies prior to the final examination.

## Syllabus

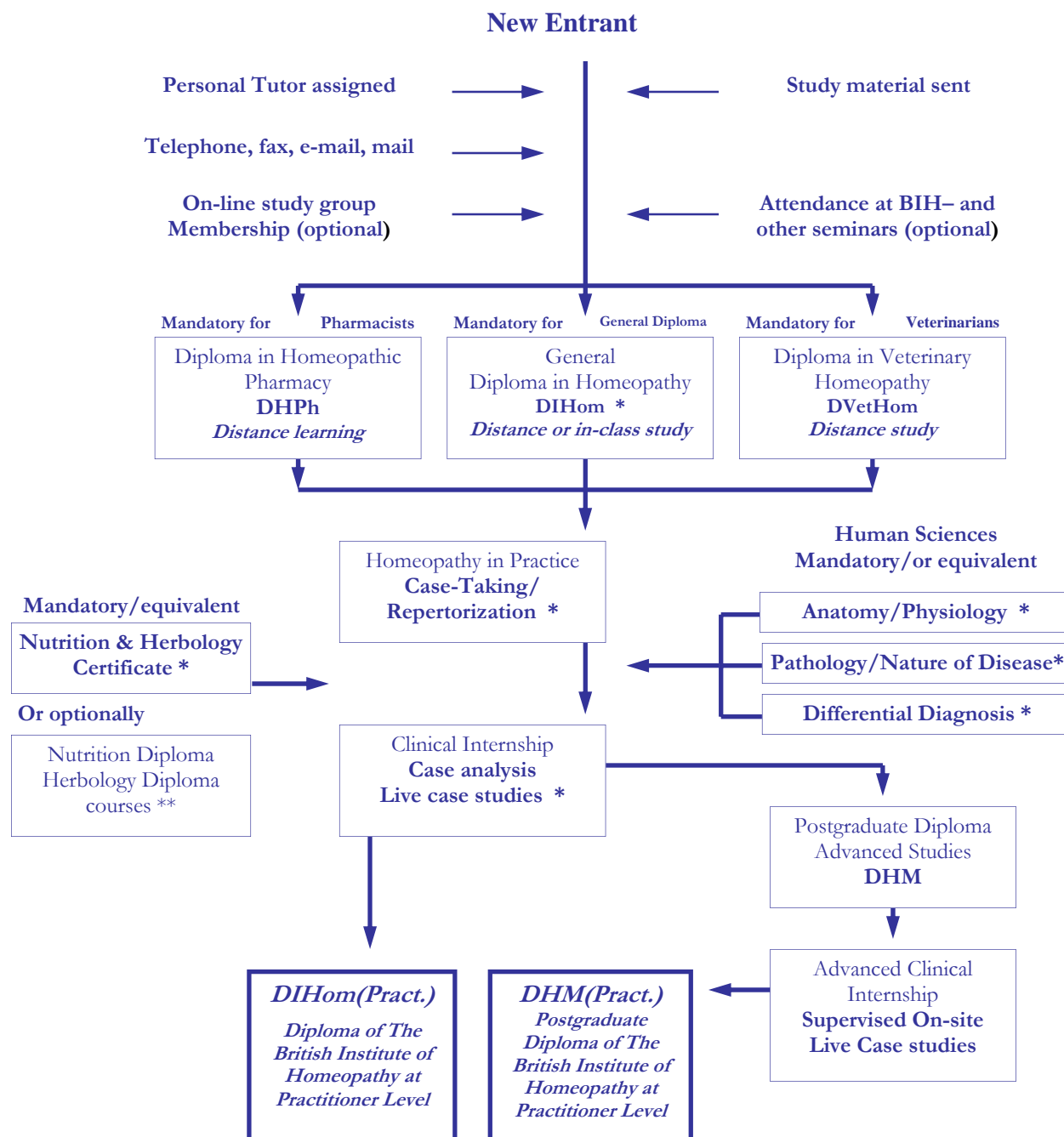

We strongly encourage students and graduates of BIHC to continue adding further courses and studies, and on-site live case-studies, not only to continuously improve their knowledge and experience, but also to increase their credit hours of training towards preparation for future standards and regulation of our profession.

# WOMEN'S HEALTH AND HOMEOPATHY

The Full Course, written by Melissa Assilem, RS Hom, FBIH and recently revamped by Vivienne Freeman, DHom, DIHom, HMD, ND, MARH, FBIH, consists of three modules covering conception to Menopause and beyond.

## Pregnancy and Childbirth

Module I covers conception to post-partum and consists of 8 written sections with an audiotape. There are 5 test papers and a final examination. Liz Henderson is the personal tutor.

### Eligibility

There are no pre-requisites except a basic knowledge of homeopathy; an Introductory Course is included. Naturally, this module of the Woman's Health Studies will be of particular benefit to registered midwives.

### Syllabus

**Clearing the way for a healthy pregnancy, sustaining the pregnancy.**

### Award

A Certificate in Women's Health is awarded on the successful completion of the course.

## Women's Health Full Course - Modules I, II, and III

The full course is by home study and consists of 18 written sections including the Pregnancy and Childbirth section, with audio tapes. The approximate duration of study is 10-12 months. There are 5 test papers and a final exam in Module I leading to a certificate in Women's Health (Midwives). Ten additional test papers and the final exam complete the Diploma in Women's Health and Homeopathy, **DWH Hom**. This course is of special benefit for Nurses and Midwives but also for General Practitioners and Practitioners of other Natural Health Therapies.

# VETERINARY HOMEOPATHY DIPLOMA

This unique distance learning course focuses on the theory and practice of the homeopathic treatment of large and small, domestic, performance, and farm animals.

Successful completion of the course leads to the award of the **Diploma in Veterinary Homeopathy, DVetHom**. The duration of study is calculated at approximately 10-12 months.

## Eligibility

This course is open to veterinary surgeons, pet owners and all those responsible for the care of domestic animals. It does not constitute a license to practice!

According to local regulations only Veterinarians may be allowed to use the designation DVetHom. All other Practitioners will receive the designation DIHom.

## Syllabus:

*The syllabus covers the homeopathic treatment of all farm, performance, and domestic animals, including cattle, sheep, pigs, horses, cats, ostriches, and other animals:*

*Homeopathic treatment of dogs, cats, horses, cattle, poultry, and of small animals; Constitutional Homeopathy in Veterinary Practice; Modalities; Veterinary Case Histories; Animal Case-Taking; Research and Development in Veterinary Homeopathy; Repertorizing; Veterinary Data; Computerized Homeopathy; Animal Nutrition; Abbreviations; A-Z Clinical Repertory of Animal Treatment; General Information; Nosodes in Veterinary Practice; Practical Homeopathic Pharmacy;*

## Award:

Successful completion is awarded with the Diploma in Homeopathy **DIHom (non-medical practitioners)**.

**Licensed Veterinarians** are awarded the **Diploma in Veterinary Homeopathy DVetHom**.

# HUMAN SCIENCES PROGRAM

## Modules I & II Anatomy/Physiology & Pathology Module III Differential Diagnosis

The Institute offers a certificated, comprehensive home study program in Human Sciences. The Institute recognizes the importance of a firm understanding in the medical sciences for all Natural Health Practitioners. Each of our courses are written by qualified medical practitioners with many years experience, and qualified medical practitioners are assigned as individual tutors.

**Course Duration:** The duration of studies is calculated at approximately 3 months each for Module I and II (Anatomy/Physiology, and Pathology), and 12 months for Module III (Differential Diagnosis).

### Eligibility

There are no specific entry requirements for this program of orthodox medicine, which is designed to support and enhance homeopathic studies and practice, or courses and practice of other complementary therapies, such as Nutrition, Herbology, Bach-Flower, etc. The course may be commenced at any time, and may be studied concurrently with other courses of the Institute. Either Module may be taken separately or in combination.

**These three Modules are requisite for the study towards the Practitioner Diploma in Homeopathy.**

### Syllabus

**Module III, Differential Diagnosis:** This substantial course is aimed at providing the confidence to the non-medically trained Practitioner to not miss potentially serious medical conditions that may require urgent medical care or treatment, and to feel secure in knowing when to refer clients to a medical practitioner for either check up or intervention. This course is considered a most important aspect of study with the Institute and is requisite for the study towards the Practitioner Diploma. It provides a bridging of the gap in education between allopathic medicine and natural health therapies.

The course consists of 27 Lessons with 10 Test Papers and two Exams, Midterm and Final. Clinical examples and questions provide insight into allopathic methods and thought. On completion of the course the student will have the confidence to recognize problematic conditions and will have a deeper understanding of the severity of certain conditions and the need for referral to a medical care taker.

## NUTRITION AND HERBOLOGY

This course provides a basic study in modern Natural Health Nutrition and Nutritional Therapy. We consider it as complementary to, and in many aspects an integral part of all Natural Health Therapies. Nutritional and Herbal medicines, such as in supplement form, are widely available in Health Food Stores and many Pharmacies and are often used alongside homeopathic therapy.

This course has been written by experts in the fields of Nutrition and Natural Health. It consists of 10 written Lessons, one audio tape, 4 Test Papers, and a Final Exam. An experienced Nutritional Practitioner is assigned as the personal tutor for this course.

**Award:** A Certificate in Nutrition and Herbology is awarded by the Institute on successful completion of the course.

# DIPLOMA IN NATURAL HEALTH NUTRITION

The British Institute of Homeopathy recognizes the fundamental role of nutrition in health. Nutrition is relevant to conventional medicine and all complementary medicines. It is interwoven in every page of medical progress. We are, therefore, proud to announce the introduction of our newly revised home study course for nutritionists; the **Diploma in Clinical Nutrition**, entitling the use of the letters **DCN**. The course has been created in collaboration with The American Council of Applied Clinical Nutrition who will provide certification to all students successfully completing the course as Fellows of The American Council of Applied Clinical Nutrition permitting the use of the letters FACACN. Graduates are also eligible for application for the Fellowship of The British Institute of Homeopathy, FBIH that entitles all Fellows to many privileges of the institute. ## Declaration of Geneva (Hippocratic Oath)

Historically, the Hippocratic Oath, dating from 400 BC, is the classic model of an ethical Code of Practice. In some ways it reflected the indentured apprentice system in the training of Physicians.

Whilst the ideals of the Hippocratic Oath are as relevant today as they were in ancient times, the invocations and language are no longer appropriate.

After the Second World War, the World Medical Association, formed in 1947 largely at the behest of the British Medical Association, adopted the Declaration of Geneva as being more appropriate in style to our times. However, the ethos of the Hippocratic Oath is retained almost in its entirety.

The Declaration of Geneva is a restatement of an intentional code of medical ethics which applies in all times. The affirmation of the Declaration of Geneva by new British Institute Graduates in Homeopathic Medicine is a public statement of their intent to maintain their highest standards of ethical conduct and respect of learning.

### To be affirmed by all DIHom (Pract.), and DHM (Pract.) Graduates of The British Institute of Homeopathy

*At the time of becoming a practicing trained Homeopath*

- I solemnly pledge myself to consecrate my life to the service of Humanity;
- I will give to my teachers the respect and gratitude which is their due;
- I will practice Homeopathy with conscience and dignity;
- The health of my clients will be my first consideration;
- I will respect the secrets which are confided in me, even after the client has passed away;
- I will maintain by all means in my power the honour and the noble traditions of homeopathic medicine;
- My colleagues will be my brothers and sisters;
- I will not permit consideration of religion, nationality, race, politics, or social standing to intervene between my duty and clients;
- I will maintain the utmost respect for human life from its beginning even under threat, and I will not use my medical knowledge contrary to the laws of Humanity;
- I make these promises solemnly, freely, and upon my honour;
